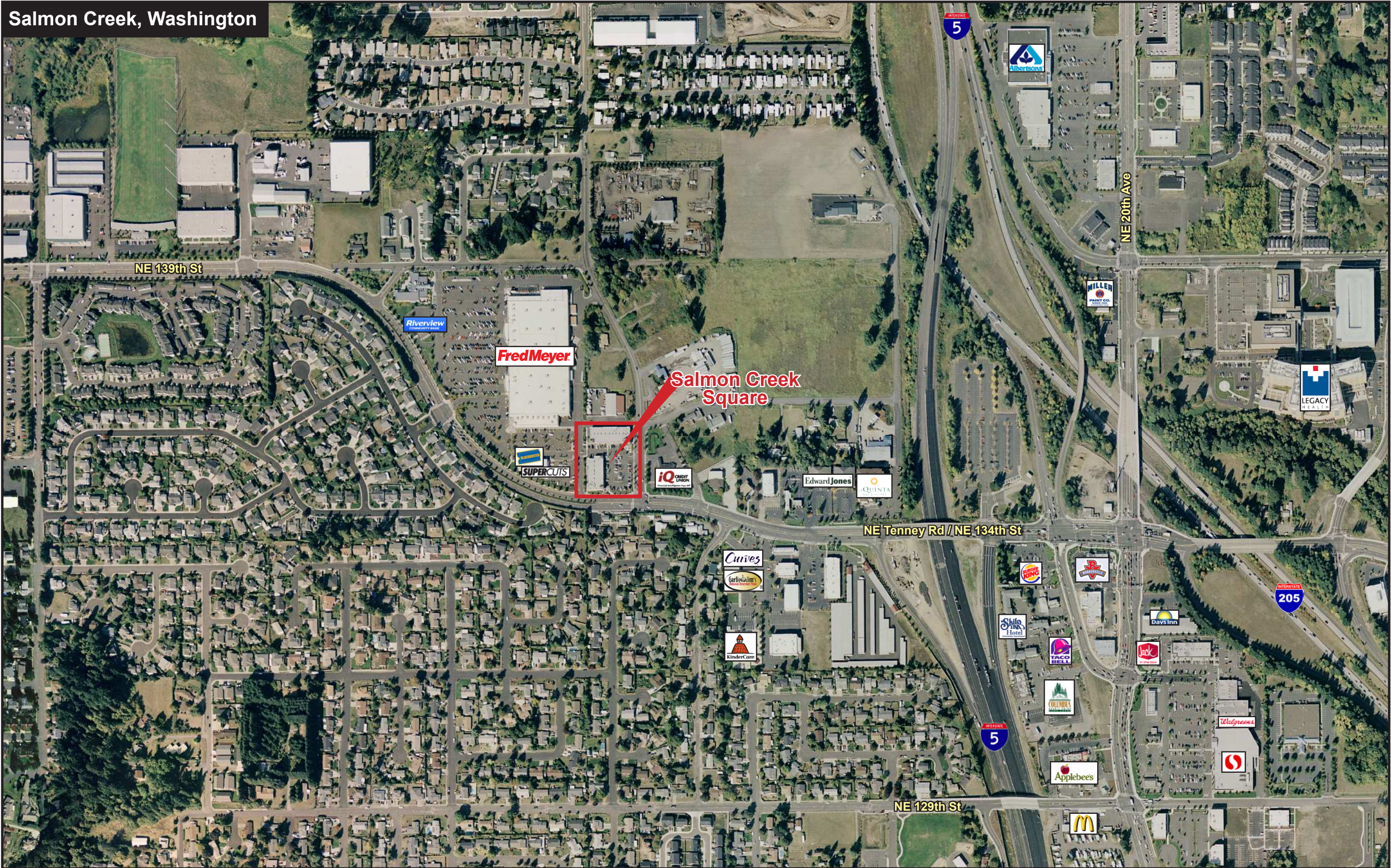

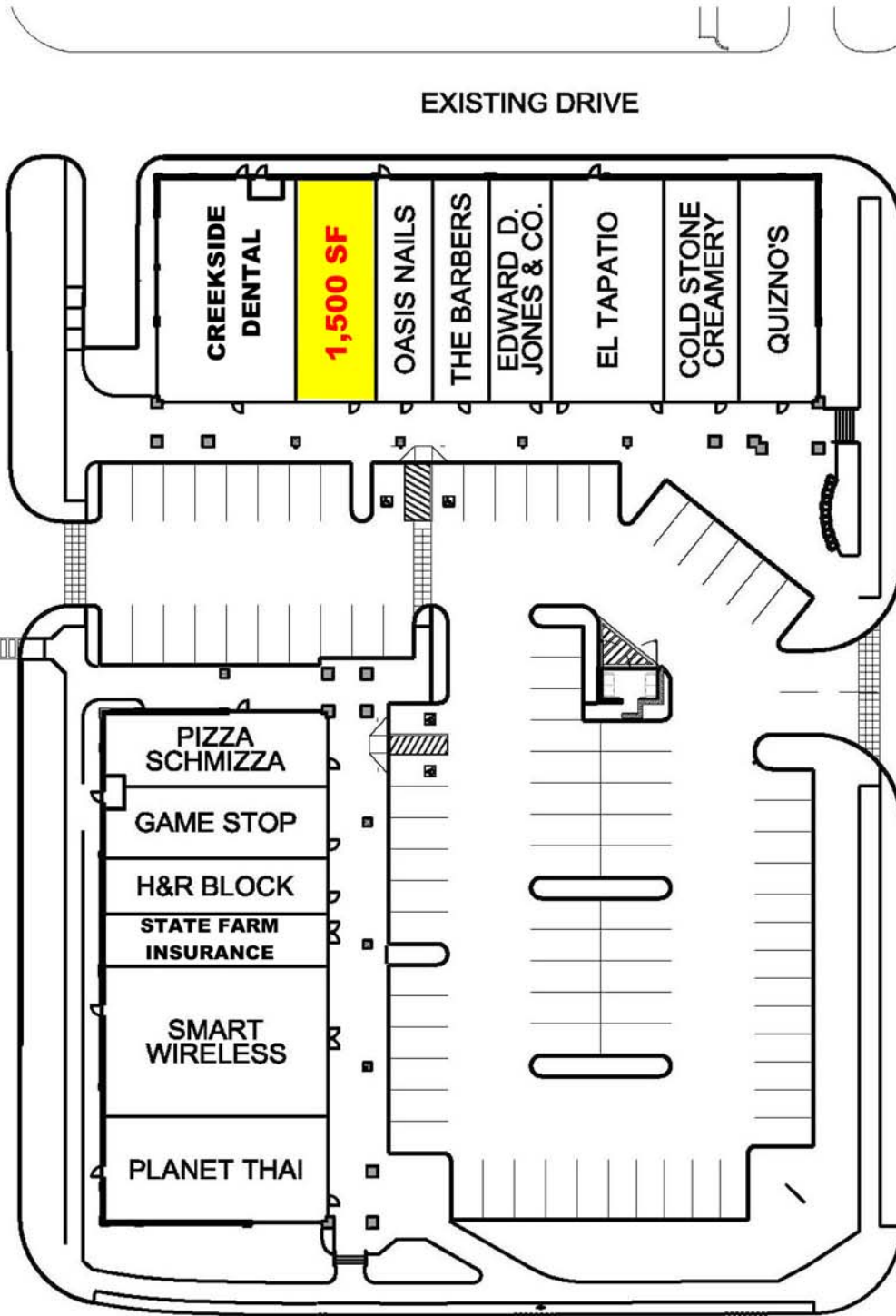

ENTRANCE TO FRED MEYER



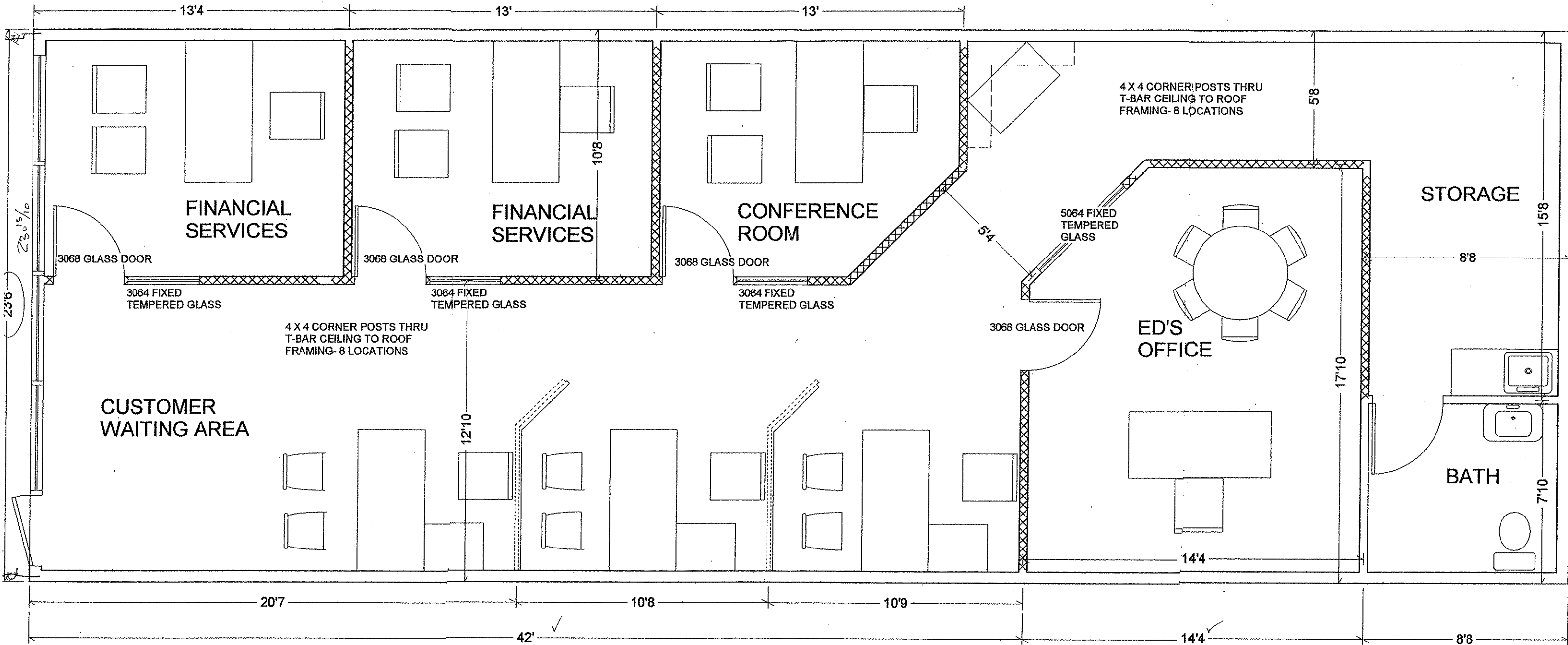

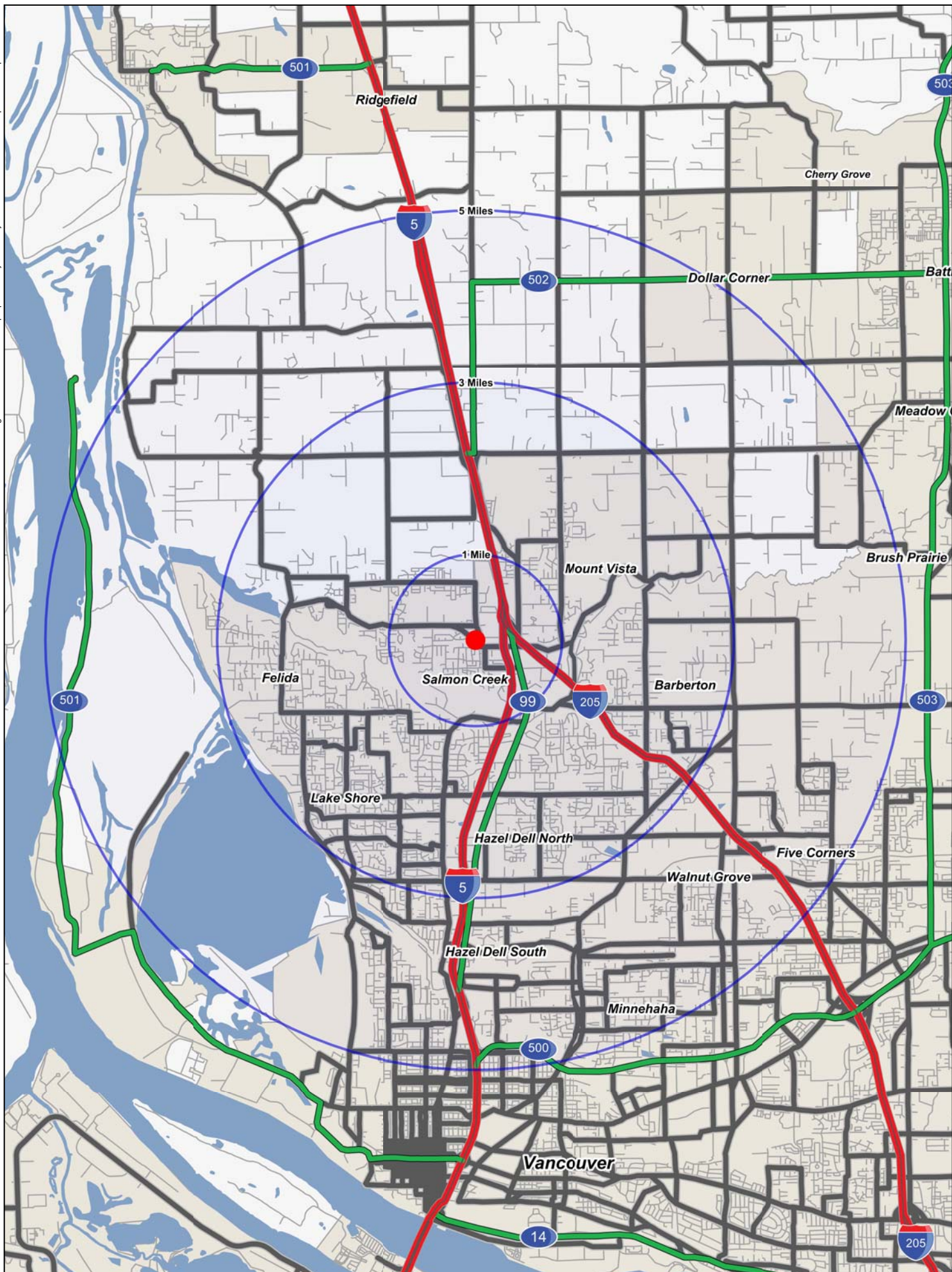
